Rostering and Single Sign on

We have all but a few applications connected to our Classlink portal now. This allows us to keep all class rosters up to date and give students and teachers a single sign on. The SSO saves teachers and students a tremendous amount of time, especially the younger students.

Chromebooks - Chromebooks have been assigned to all 3rd-12th grade students and Charging carts are now in KG-2nd grade classrooms.

More network upgrade: We continue to work daily to clean up and document our infrastructure and network cabling. We have made great progress. All of the core equipment has been replaced in the schools. All switches have been replaced across the district with the exception of Harrison. Harrison will be totally complete the first week of school.

Classroom panels: All panels have been installed! The teachers love them!

Surplus equipment: We have recycled 12 pallets of old computer equipment from old North. The remaining 5 pallets will be picked up within the next few weeks.
