#### **Vision & Mission**

- Committee followed detailed process to develop draft vision and mission statements:
  - SWOT Analysis
  - Conversations about 'Ideal Future'
  - Review of previous plan
  - Review of input
  - Mission vs. Vision: mission is present tense; vision is future objective

#### **Vision & Mission Statements**

- One-sentence statements describing the reason your organization exists – what you do, who/what you do this for and the future you envision
- Statements should be:
  - •Clear easy to understand, concrete language
  - Concise short and to the point
  - •Useful inform, focus, guide
  - Memorable






#### **Town Halls**




## What are the most important beliefs or guiding principles that should direct the work of PGCPS in the years ahead?




What do you believe are strengths of the PGCPS?




### What are the most important challenges PGCPS will have to address in the years ahead in the area of student achievement/instruction?




### What are the most important challenges PGCPS will have to address in the years ahead in the area of human resources?



## What are the most important challenges PGCPS will have to address in the years ahead in the area of professional learning?






