VIII. ACTION ITEMS

A. Health, Dental and Vision Insurance Rates for FY2022 – Monique Barnes

Mrs. Barnes presented health, dental and vision rates for FY2022. A 7.97% increase is expected for the Anthem health insurance plan, a 4% increase in rates for the Delta Dental plan and no change in rates for the Blue Vision policy.

Mr. Smith made a motion to approve the health, dental and vision rates as presented for FY2022. Ms. Taylor seconded the motion.

 - B. Contract Extension of Superintendent

Mr. Eley stated that prior to the final year of the superintendent's contract, a determination is made if an extension will be granted beyond the final year. The School Board has determined that an extension will be offered commencing on July 1, 2021 and end on June 30, 2025 with terms and conditions set forth in the contract negotiated with Dr. Pennycuff.

Ms. Taylor made a motion to approve the contract extension for Dr. Pennycuff with new term commencing on July 1, 2021 and end on June 30, 2025 with terms and conditions set forth in the contract negotiated with Dr. Pennycuff.

IX. DISCUSSION ITEMS

A. Comprehensive Planning Committee Update – Lisa Pennycuff, Betsy Overkamp-Smith

Mrs. Overkamp-Smith provided an update on the 2022-2027 Comprehensive Plan and reiterated the Vision, Mission and draft Goals and Objectives of the Comprehensive Plan. For each proposed goal, there are objectives, and each objective has strategies. These goals, objectives, and strategies may be found on the attached presentation. She emphasized that this is still a working document, and the definitions may change before the final version in July 2021. The committee will meet in May and June and a copy of the final Comprehensive Plan draft will be presented to the School Board in July.

B. Capital Improvement Planning – Dustin Menhart

The school division must develop a Capital Improvement Plan (CIP) annually that outlines the schools' capital improvement needs for the next ten years. The school division's CIP is generally due to be considered with the County's overall budget consideration during August/September. Tyler Whatley (Moseley Architects) and April McKelvey (Monarch Consulting Services) joined via Zoom to review HVAC facility assessments and Comprehensive Roofing Asset Evaluation, respectively.

Moseley Architects provided an assessment of several schools (Beazley, South, North, Harrison, Moore, Clements, Prince George High Schools) of their existing conditions and prioritization of upgrades/replacements with estimated costs for each school anticipated over the next 5-7 years. A chart of the HVAC priority/ranking and associated estimated budget costs is attached. Items prioritized and ranked included a cost of \$2,135,000 to bring to a good level or \$6,285,000 for a better level.

Monarch Consulting Services was tasked to perform a comprehensive roof evaluation of all eight buildings and ascertain the existing condition of the roof systems and determine the remaining service life for each individual roof section. Forty-one percent of the roofing inventory is anticipated to need replacement within the next five years and fifty-three percent within the next decade (see attached summary page). Water leak repair is considered a priority for safety issues. Some school roof areas need replacing while others need repair. We will repair, not replace, the roofs at Walton and Beazley since a new school is being built to replace Walton and Beazley will be the next school replaced. Some roofs can be patched to extend the life of the roof to eliminate leaks. There was considerable discussion relating to the roofing/gutter issues at J.E.J. Moore Middle School. It has been determined there is a design flaw (valley and gutter undersized) that has contributed to problems of water intrusion. Steps are being taken to find root cause of water intrusion. Dr. Pennycuff has asked to replace the undersized gutters, solution to keep water away from the building (underground grates), and add bottom seals to the doors. Mr. Johnson requested a diagram of inlet for outflow of where water goes. Additional information on the ten-year plan included annual replacement of buses, high school auditorium renovation plans, etc.
